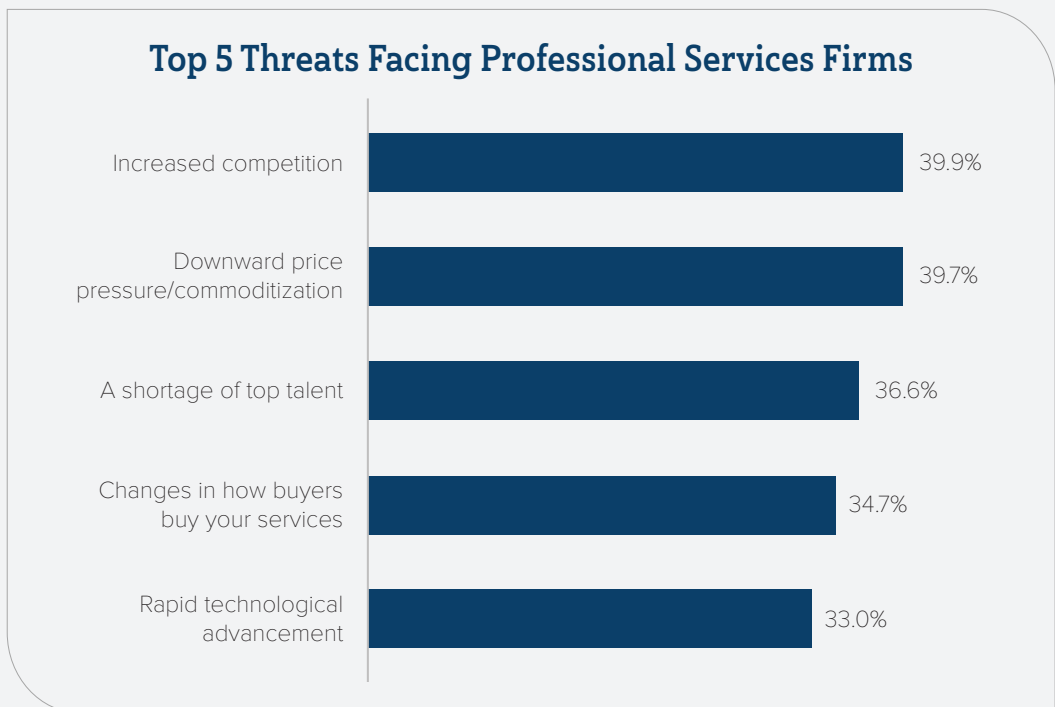
Top Reasons for Making the Move to Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central with Advanced Project Accounting

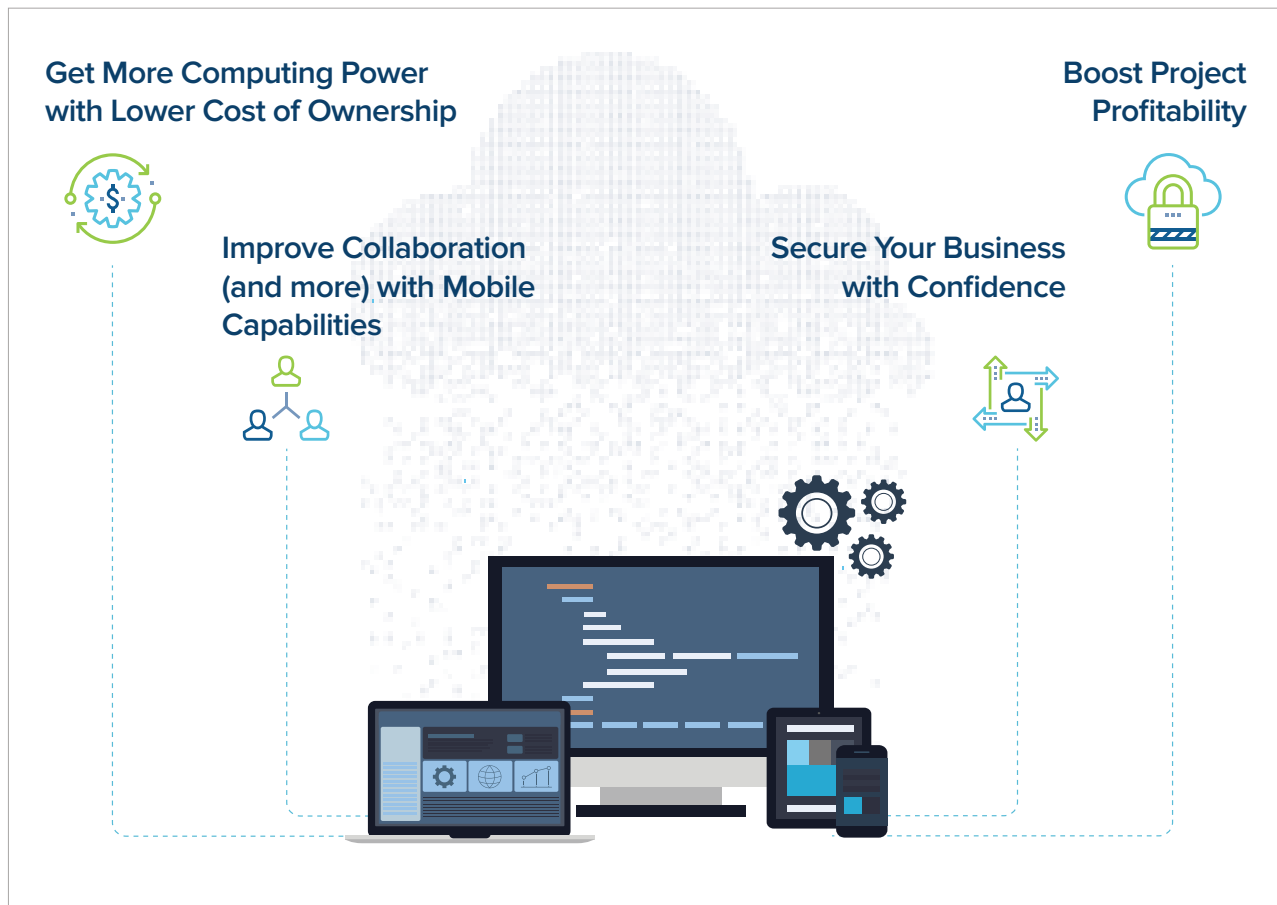
Scenario #2: Total Costs of On-Premise Systems

A new potential client was considering implementing an on-premise ERP system. Based on their configuration requirements: the up-front cost for implementation would include more than \$60,000 in new hardware; \$20,000 in new software; and an additional operating spend for upgrading the server room. On top of that, the company would need to hire a senior IT person at \$100K+ annually who would be responsible for managing their on-premise environment and future maintenance and upgrades.

In both business scenarios, the companies leveraged Microsoft Dynamics 365 cloud-based business applications to resolve their challenge.

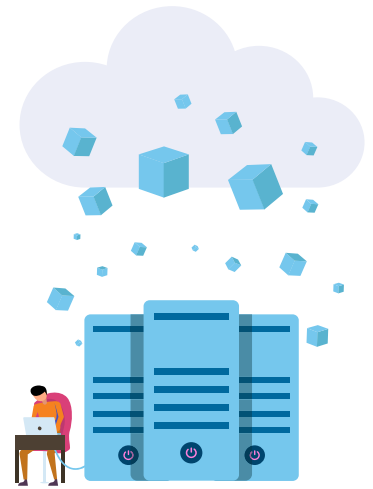
